PROJECT BENEFITS

HEALTHY FARM ANIMALS AND EFFECTIVE DISEASE CONTROL

High animal health standards protect human and animal health and welfare as well as enhance food safety. Efficient animal health surveillance system promotes smooth and safe trade of live animals and products of animal origin



PROJECT BENEFITS

- Animal health surveillance system will be strengthened:
 - disease outbreak management, institutional cooperation and capacity improved
- ✓ skills and knowledge of veterinary specialists involved in disease control enhanced
- Animal disease control strategy for Georgia developed
- Activities to achieve officially free status for certain diseases as a prerequisite for the international trade of animals and products initiated

HEALTHY PLANTS, DEVELOPED ECONOMY

Healthy plants ensure the production of agricultural products and the conservation of biological diversity. Monitoring of plant protection products, pest risk analysis and phytosanitary monitoring programme are important to prevent introduction of new harmful organisms into the country

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Production of healthy and high-quality plant products will be maintained
- Export of plant origin products will be encouraged
- Georgia's landscape will be preserved

IMPROVED, RISK-BASED IMPORT CONTROL SYSTEM

Effective border control system is important to protect consumers from low quality and unsafe import products and the country itself from various animal diseases and plant pests

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Animals, plant and animal origin products imported into Georgia will be checked more effectively
- Import control procedures will be improved
- Professional knowledge of inspectors will be increased



STRONG, EFFECTIVE AND RELIABLE CONTROL SYSTEM

- Information exchange between supervisory authorities in crisis situations and in cases of outbreaks will be improved
- Confidence of consumers and stakeholders in the Georgian food safety surveillance system will be strengthened
- Cooperation between private sector and public authorities will be more effective
