<b>IMPORT PROHIBITED</b>		
<b>1. Meat, meat products ****</b> (fresh meat, smoked meat, semi-finished meat products, meat products and meat preparations and other)	<b>0 kg</b>	<b>Permitted to introduce:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. From the <b>Faroe Islands, Greenland</b> if the quantity of meat or meat products, milk or milk products does not exceed <b>10 kg</b> per one person.</li> <li>2. Milk powder for infants, infant food and special food, which is required due to medical reasons, on the condition, that:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ the products do not need be cooled before consumption;</li> <li>✓ the products are patented company products and packed;</li> <li>✓ the packing has not been damaged, except, if the respective product is being used and if:</li> <li>✓ the country of origin thereof the <b>Faroe Islands, Greenland</b> with a weight limit of 10 kg per person;</li> <li>✓ from other countries if total quantity does not exceed 2 kg per person.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>

<b>6. Foodstuffs consisting of dried beans originating from Nigeria ***</b>	0 kg	
<b>IMPORT PROHIBITED WITHOUT RELEVANT CERTIFICATE AND/OR FOOD AND VETERINARY SERVICE (fvs) CONTROL</b>		
<b>7. Products listed in Annex I to Regulation 2019/1793</b>	<b>Over 30kg</b>	<b>Submit to FVS for control!</b>
<b>8. Products listed in Annex II to Regulation 2019/1793</b>		<b>Submit to FVS for control!</b> An official certificate issued by a third country is required.
<b>9. Plants for planting */** including seeds, grafts, cuttings</b>		<b>Submit to FVS for control!</b> Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a third country is required.
<b>10. Fresh plant products *</b> (fruits, vegetables, nuts in shell, flowers e.c.)	<b>Over 2kg</b> (Total weight)	<b>Submit to FVS for control!</b> Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a third country is required.
<b>PERMITTED TO INTRODUCE</b>		
<b>11. Other products of animal origin ****</b> (eggs, honey and other) or products containing raw materials of animal origins	<b>2 kg</b>	Total quantity thereof does not exceed <b>2 kg</b> per one person.
<b>12. Fishery products ****</b> (fresh, dried, thermally processed, salted or smoked fish and some crustaceans)	<b>20 kg</b>	The condition for the introduction of <b>fresh, healthy</b> fish: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ The fish has been cleaned</li> <li>✓ The weight of fishery products or the weight of one fish per one person does not exceed <b>20 kg</b>, depending on which is higher.</li> </ul> <b>Crustaceans</b> , for instance, shrimps, lobsters, non-live mussels and non-live oysters.
<b>13. Products of animals of endangeres species****</b>	<b>Caviar – 125 grams</b>	Additional restrictions may be in force regarding some protected species. <b>Caviar of the sturgeon species of fish = not more than 125 grams per one person.</b>
<b>14. Fresh plant products</b> (fruits, vegetables, nuts in shell, flowers, e.c.) *	<b>Up to 2kg</b> (Total weight)	Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a third country is required. <b>No need FVS for control!</b>
<b>15. Fresh fruit: bananas, coconuts, dates, pineapple, durians *</b>		Without limitations.
<b>16. Processed non-food food of animal origin</b> (beverages, confectionery, sweets, tea, coffee, e.c.)		For the products referred to in paragraphs 8 and 9 up to <b>30 kg</b> .***
