(Unofficial Translation by the Korean Embassy)

- 1. Regarding the inspection of imported fishery products, the Republic of Korea does not require the attachment of sanitary (health) certificate for the Latvian fishery products.
- 2. The processing establishments (facilities), of the exporting countries, producing the frozen edible fish head and frozen edible fish intestines, however, should be registered at, and managed by, the Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety, and should observe the specific procedures (please refer to the attached letter concerning the main points of Korea's notification to the WTO in this regard). A sanitary (health) certificate should also be issued by the relevant inspection agency recognized by the Government of the exporting country.
 - * Fishery by-products can be imported only from the following 27 countries:

France, Japan, Peru, Philippines, Chile, Uruguay, Iceland, Ecuador, Singapore, Russia, Micronesia, United States, Mauritius, New Zealand, Norway, Thailand, Indonesia, Vietnam, China, South Africa, United Kingdom, Ukraine, Panama, Argentina, Fiji, Falkland Islands, Spain
